For an easy transportation option, may we suggest a MetroCard. A Metro Card gives you unlimited use of the Subway and Busses in New York City. Depending on the length of your stay, you may want a 1-Day Fun Pass or a 7-DayCard.


1-Day Fun Pass Cost: \$7.50, reduced fare not available

Good for unlimited subway and local bus rides from first use until 3 a.m. the following day. Sold at MetroCard Vending Machines and at neighborhood stores. Not available at station booths. [Where to Buy](#)


7-Day Unlimited Ride MetroCard Cost: \$25, reduced fare \$12.50

Good for unlimited subway and local bus rides until midnight, 7 days from day of first use. [Where to Buy](#)
